They were filled with great awe and said to one another, “Who then is this whom even wind and sea obey?” (Mk 4:41)



St. Thomas More

Thomas More was an English lawyer, philosopher, author, statesman and Renaissance humanist, serving Henry VIII as Lord High Chancellor of England from October 1529 to May 1532.

Thomas was born in London on February 7, 1478 to a prominent family who greatly influenced him in a positive way. He was an educated man having attended St. Anthony's School and Oxford. There he learned Latin and Greek, seeking to become a lawyer. He trained in London until 1502 when he was approved to begin practice. In 1503 he started thinking about a different plan for his life. He lived next door to a monastery and admired their simple lifestyle, often joining with them to pray. But by the next year, he decided to stay in the secular area and ran for a seat in Parliament. The influence of the monks inspired and remained with him.

Thomas married Jane Colt in 1505, having four children before her death in 1511. They had a happy marriage. He remarried Alice Harpur Middleton soon after, wanting a stepmother for his children. This marriage was not as happy as the first. He was a good father, treating his sons and daughters equally, including for schooling. He adopted Alice's daughter from her previous marriage. In 1504, Thomas was elected to Parliament to represent the Great Yarmouth region and then in 1510 rose to represent London. He earned a reputation as being honest and effective and became a Privy Counselor in 1514. He began working at the many positions given to him by Henry VIII and was knighted. Thomas became Lord Chancellor in 1529, working hard, was fair minded and loyal to the king. He prosecuted people accused of heresy and worked to defend the Catholic faith in England, but he couldn't support the King when Henry wanted an annulment from his wife, Catherine.

Thomas refused to sign a letter to the Pope requesting the annulment, which was his first time opposing the King. Henry then broke away from the Church forcing many to join with him. Thomas wouldn't do this and resigned in 1532. He also refused to accept Anne Boleyn as the new Queen. He was ordered to take an oath agreeing that Henry was the head of the church and the annulment was legitimate, but Thomas would not do this and was sent to the Tower. Even though he stayed silent, he was found guilty of treason and was beheaded. Just before his death in 1535 he said that he was "the king's good servant, but God's first."

His book, Utopia, published in 1516, described the political system of an imaginary island state, which is still considered one of the greatest works of the late Renaissance and remains read by scholars today.

St. Thomas More is the patron saint of adopted children, lawyers, civil servants, politicians and difficult marriages. He was beatified on December 29, 1886 by Pope Leo XIII and canonized on May 19, 1935 by Pope Pius XI. His feast day is June 22.


