Pastor's Message
Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

When they had had their fill, he said to his disciples, "Gather the fragments left over, so that nothing will be wasted." (Jn. 6:12)

After satisfying the human needs of his hungry followers, Jesus instructs his disciples to *gather the fragments left over, so that nothing will be wasted*, and they collect twelve wicker baskets full...Jesus' miracle prefigured the superabundance of the Eucharist (CCC 1335). For from the shores of the Sea of Galilee, Jesus would travel to Jerusalem, and there, he would institute the Eucharist the night before he died - a perpetual memorial of his sacrifice.

Two thousand years later, we, too, gather to listen to Jesus and to implore him with our needs. We, too, watch as the priest takes the bread, gives thanks, and distributes it to us - another unworthy and hungry crowd. We feast at the Lord's table. We encounter Jesus - the bread of life - under simple forms of bread and wine.

What do we do with the leftovers? St. Paul tells the Ephesians *to live in a manner worthy of the call you have received, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another through love, striving to preserve the unity of the spirit through the bond of peace*. This is the job description for Christians! We have the obligation to use the gift of the Eucharist in the service of others. Doing so would be sharing the Father's love to make the world better, to strive for unity and peace. This is our mission.

I, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to live in a manner worthy of the call you have received, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another through love, striving to preserve the unity of the spirit through the bond of peace: one body and one Spirit...(Eph 4:1-4)



St. Martha

Martha of Bethany, her sister Mary and brother Lazarus were friends with Jesus. She was born sometime in the first century.

Martha often invited Jesus to her home at Bethany, located on the southeastern slope of the Mount of Olives, which was a few miles from Jerusalem. There are three visits written in the gospels of Luke 10:38-42, John 11:1-53 and John 12:1-9 which speak of this.

She believed in the importance of hospitality and was frustrated with her sister Mary, who didn't serve but just sat and listened to Jesus speak, so she complained about this to him. Jesus' response was that Martha worried about too many distracting things, but Mary was listening to him, which was more important. Still, Jesus appreciated Martha all the same.

"Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus." John's gospel tells us of the special relationship Jesus had with Martha, her sister and her brother. When Lazarus became sick, Martha sent word to Jesus, who soon came to the house. But Lazarus had already died and was buried. Jesus told Martha that her brother would rise again, but she misunderstood.

Jesus said to Martha "I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die". Then Jesus said to move the stone from the tomb and called out to Lazarus, who walked out of the tomb. He was risen from the dead by a miracle. Martha became even more devoted to Jesus.

Martha always stayed in the background not craving the spotlight. She wasn't showy, but simply served Jesus. Not much else is known about Martha except according to a legend Martha accompanied Mary and Lazarus to evangelize France after Pentecost.

St. Martha is represented in Christian Art wearing a simple garment, with a ladle or skimmer in her hand. Sometimes, she is depicted with a container of holy water and a dragon at her feet because according to another legend, she went to Tarascon, France, where she overpowered the Tarasque, a legendary dragon like mythological hybrid animal which was concealed on the banks of the Rhone in the neighborhood of Aix in Provence.

St. Martha is the patron saint of butlers, hotel keepers, laundry workers, maids, housewives, cooks and domestic workers because of her willingness to serve. Many can easily identify with her.

She is also the patron saint of travelers and Villajoyosa, Spain, where the town honors St. Martha annually by celebrating "The Festival of Moors and Christians." This festival has been held for the last 250 years, remembering the attack on Villajoyosa by Berber pirates in 1538. According to this legend, St. Martha came to the rescue of the townsfolk by causing a flash flood which wiped out the enemy fleet, thus preventing them from reaching the coast.

St. Martha died in 84 AD. Her feast day is July 29 and her relics are kept in the church dedicated to her in Tarascon France – Church of St. Martha also known as Église Sainte-Marthe de Tarascon.
