## Pastor's Message

### Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

***"...I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." (Jn. 6:51)***

This is a pivotal section in Jesus' ministry, because this is the time when many who follow him will find his words difficult to hear, and will leave him. We don't hear that part yet. What we do hear is the truth and foundation of what we profess and believe when we offer our "Amen" when receiving the body and blood of Christ. Jesus is *the bread that came down from heaven*. And in partaking of this bread - his body, blood, soul and divinity, we are changed. We become united with God and his work. We are then sent forward to make God's kingdom present on earth through our own efforts.

He is more than a messenger of God or even a prophet like Moses. Jesus is God's son... Eating this bread not only sustains us for our labors, but it fundamentally changes us... To be *imitators of God, as beloved children, and live in love, as Christ loved us*.

## St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross

Edith Stein was born in Breslau, Germany (now Wroclaw, Poland) on October 12, 1891 to a Jewish family on the holy day of Yom Kippur. She was the youngest of eleven children and was fondly called Yitschel. Her father died when she was two years old, leaving her mother to take care of her family and the business. As she grew older, Edith lost her faith in God.

In 1911 Edith enrolled at the University of Breslau to study German and history. Her real interests were philosophy and women's issues, so she joined the Prussian Society for Women's Suffrage, becoming a "radical suffragette", later losing interest in this. She transferred to Gottingen University in 1913 to study philosophy and work on her doctorate, slowly finding her way to the Christian faith. During World War One, Edith served in an Austrian field hospital. In 1917, she received her *doctorate summa cum laude* after writing a thesis on "The Problem of Empathy", which was her first encounter with the Cross and its power, after having met a woman of faith who influenced her. In autumn of 1918, Edith left her job as a teaching assistant. She wanted to become a professor, but at that time women were not granted this position. Also, she was Jewish which further prohibited this.

One night, Edith saw an autobiography of St. Teresa of Avila and read this book all night, which led her to her baptism on January 1, 1922. After her conversion she went straight to Breslau, where she told her mother that she became a Catholic. Both women cried. She wanted to enter a convent, but instead taught German and history at the Dominican Sisters' school and a teacher-training college at St Magdalen's Convent in Speyer until Easter of 1931. She did extensive speaking engagements on women's issues relating to women's rights and education, was known for her phenomenological work on empathy, translated the letters and diaries of Cardinal Newman from his pre-Catholic period as well as Thomas Aquinas' *De Veritate (Of Truth)* into German and also wrote *Potency and Act*, a study of the central concepts developed by Thomas Aquinas. Later at the Carmelite convent in Cologne she re-wrote this study to produce her main philosophical and theological study, *Finite and Eternal Being*. She combined faith and scholarship, being well known as a philosopher. In 1932 she accepted a teaching post in the Roman Catholic division of the German Institute for Educational Studies at the University of Münster, where she taught as "tool of the Lord".

In 1933, the Nazis came to power. Their law requiring an Aryan Certificate made it impossible for Edith to continue to teach because all civil servants, including teachers, needed to produce this document for employment.

Now she entered the Carmelite convent in Cologne on October 14, 1933 as a postulant and became a nun on April 21, 1938 as Sister Teresa Benedicta of the Cross. She was smuggled across the border into Holland to the Carmelite convent in Echt. Here she wrote two of her most significant theological treatises, *The Science of the Cross* and *Ways to Know God*. Sister Teresa Benedicta was arrested by the Gestapo on August 2, 1942 while she was in the chapel with the other sisters, including her own sister Rosa, a tertiary of the Order, who also converted. They and the other Jewish Christians were taken to a transit camp in Amersfoort, then to Westerbork and finally to Auschwitz, where they were gassed on August 9, 1942.

Teresa Benedicta of the Cross was beatified as a martyr by Pope John Paul II on May 1, 1987 in Cologne, Germany and then was canonized by him eleven years later on October 11, 1998 in Rome. Her feast day is August 9.

St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross is one of the six co-patron saints of Europe, along with St. Benedict of Nursia, Saints Cyril and Methodius, St. Catherine of Siena and St. Bridget of Sweden.
