## **Pastor's Message/Mensaje del Pastor**

### **Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time/Vigesimo Primer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario**

*Simon Peter answered him, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God."(Jn 6:68-69)*

Today's gospel is the conclusion of the Bread of Life Discourse in the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John... No other chapter receives such attention in the Sunday liturgy. In this chapter, Jesus has walked on water and fed thousands with the loaves and fishes. He has announced himself as the true bread sent down from heaven, and made it clear that those who do not eat his flesh and drink his blood will not have eternal life.

This is where the crowds took issue with Jesus. This is where they had to decide what they were going to do - whether they would choose to continue following him or not. And, for the first and only time in any of the Gospels, some disciples chose to stop believing in Jesus and would follow him no further...

*Do you also want to leave?* Jesus asks the Apostles. Perhaps he is asking the same thing of us. Jesus' life is about servant leadership and a total commitment to the fulfillment of the will of the Father. He gives himself to God and to us completely, especially on the cross and in the Eucharist. In Jesus, there is no room for self-doubt, a divided heart, or a lackluster effort... To express our belief in Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist, we come to the altar offering our Amen to his Truth.

*"If it does not please you to serve the LORD, decide today whom you will serve, the gods your fathers served beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites in whose country you are now dwelling. As for me and my household, we will serve the LORD."(Joshua 24: 2).*

Se ha anunciado a sí mismo como el verdadero pan enviado del cielo y ha dejado claro que los que no comen su carne ni beben su sangre no tendrán vida eterna.

Aquí es donde las multitudes se opusieron a Jesús. Aquí es donde tenían que decidir qué iban a hacer, si optarían por seguirlo o no. Y, por primera y única vez en cualquiera de los evangelios, algunos discípulos optaron por dejar de creer en Jesús y no lo seguirían más ...

¿También quieres irte? Jesús les pregunta a los apóstoles. Quizás nos esté pidiendo lo mismo. La vida de Jesús se trata de un liderazgo de servicio y un compromiso total con el cumplimiento de la voluntad del Padre. Se entrega completamente a Dios ya nosotros, especialmente en la cruz y en la Eucaristía. En Jesús, no hay lugar para la duda, un corazón dividido o un esfuerzo mediocre ... Para expresar nuestra fé en la Presencia Real de Cristo en la Eucaristía, venimos al altar ofreciendo nuestro Amén a su Verdad.

**"Si no te agrada servir al SEÑOR, decide hoy a quién servirás, a los dioses que sirvieron tus padres al otro lado del río o a los dioses de los amorreos en cuyo país ahora moras. En cuanto a mí y mi casa, serviremos al SEÑOR "(Josué 24: 2).**





## ***St. Monica and St. Augustine***

Saint Monica, the mother of St. Augustine of Hippo, was born in 332 in Algeria. She was very young when she married a pagan with a violent temper. His mother also was very nasty and lived with them. There were constant arguments and adultery issues. They had three children, one of whom was Augustine. None were baptized because her husband would not allow this. Monica endured the ways of her husband and mother-in-law for many years and prayed for them. One year before his death, she converted both.

Two of her children eventually entered the religious life, but Augustine was lazy and rude. After her husband's death, she sent Augustine to Carthage for schooling when he was seventeen. In 370, Augustine discovered works done by Cicero and came to love the idea of wisdom and wanted to find this in religion, even Christianity, but he did not agree with any of the religions. Then he became a Manichaean, observing a religion about light and darkness from Persia. When he returned home and told this to his mother, she told him to leave her home, so he went to Italy. Monica continued to cry and pray for her son and then went to Rome looking for him, but he was now in Milan. At this point, Augustine had a mistress and was living a life of sin, with worldly ambitions and associations with people of loose morals. He was very intelligent, but he had no faith. Monica continued her journey and met St. Ambrose, who helped her convert Augustine to Christianity following his seventeen-year resistance.

Through the prayers of his mother and the preaching of St. Ambrose, Augustine finally realized that Christianity was the one true religion. It took a while for him to become a Christian. Monica and Augustine spent six peaceful months at *Rus Cassiacum* after which Augustine was baptized by St. Ambrose in the church of St. John the Baptist in Milan at the Easter Vigil in April, 387. The letters of St. Paul also influenced his conversion. Augustine had been split between his mother and mistress, but finally separated from her and embraced his mother's religion. Monica kept praying and was patient and God had heard her prayers.

Monica and Augustine left for Africa. While they were in Ostia, Monica died. Augustine was filled with grief, which inspired his book *Confessions*. In one passage, he wrote about Monica's habit of bringing "to certain oratories, erected in the memory of the saints, offerings of porridge, bread, water and wine." Other important works written by Augustine include *The City of God*, *On Christian Doctrine* and *Soliloquies of Augustine*.

Augustine became a priest, bishop, writer and started the order of the Augustinians, a religious group of friars. He was very charitable, devout and lived in poverty yet supported the poor.

His many important works influenced the development of western philosophy and Christianity. He established his own approach to philosophy and theology using many methods and perspectives. Augustine died in 430 and is viewed as one of the most important Fathers of the Catholic Church. He is a Doctor of the Church and one of the greatest saints of the Church.

St. Monica's feast day is August 27. She is the patron saint of patience, mothers, wives, abuse victims and alcoholics.

St. Augustine's feast day is August 28. He is the patron saint of brewers, printers, theologians and several cities and dioceses, including the Diocese and the Basilica of St. Augustine in Florida.
