..."Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that he will take from what is mine and declare it to you." (John 16:15)

Jesus Christ came to rescue us from the wages of sin and death, and give us hope. All the readings today, on this Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, show us that hope. Christ has justified us and given us a share of his cross, and because of his cross the Holy Spirit is given to us to find strength in adversity. The Holy Spirit guides us into truth.

Every single day, as we navigate our lives, the Holy Spirit is offering us grace to be acted upon. Our prayer today, as we celebrate the fullness of divinity as a Trinity, is that we be aware of and act on the actual graces given to us throughout our everyday lives; that the Spirit gives us the Wisdom to always see the truth. For God is indeed our hope.

Not only that, but we even boast of our afflictions, knowing that affliction produces endurance, and endurance, proven character, and proven character, hope, and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.(Rom 5:3-5)



ONE HUNDRED EIGHT BLESSED POLISH MARTYRS

The One Hundred Eight Blessed Polish Martyrs were Roman Catholics from Poland killed during World War II by the Nazis. The group comprised of three bishops, seventy nine priests, seven male religious, eight female religious and eleven lay people.



There are two parishes named for the Martyrs in Powiercie in Koło County, Poland and in Malbork, Poland.

Ludwik Pius Bartosik and Jan Antonin Bajewski were the closest collaborators of St. Maximilian Kolbe, also killed by the Nazis.

These brave men and women were killed at Dachau, Stutthof, Auschwitz, Działdowo, Sachsenhausen, Bielsk Podlaski, Rosica, Belarus, Piaśnica, Pomerania, Mauthausen, Sachsenhausen, Warsaw, Plonkowo, Berezwecz, Majdanek, Hartheim, Berezwecz, Gross-Rosen, Gusen, Dresden, Piaśnica, Pomerania, Góra Pietrelewicka, Dzialdow, Kalisz prison and Ravensbrück.

Some were shot by the Gestapo, while others were burned, gassed, starved or guillotined.

The Martyrs were beatified by Pope John Paul II in Warsaw on June 13, 1999 and their feastday is June 12.




