



## Our Lady of Luján By Marylu Mariniello

Our Lady of Luján is a famous sixteenth-century statue of the Blessed Mother, which is displayed at the Basilica of Our Lady of Luján in Argentina.

The Luján statue was made in Brazil and then was sent to Argentina. It is said that in 1630, a settler ordered the terracotta image of the Immaculate Conception because he wanted to create a shrine in her honor. This was to help reinvigorate the Catholic faith in Santiago del Estero, his town. After leaving the port of Buenos Aires, the caravan carrying the image stopped at the residence of Don Rosendo Oramas, who lived in Zelaya. When the caravan began to leave, the oxen would not move. The animals were replaced by another team, but they wouldn't move either. When the statue was taken out from the cart, the oxen began walking. People found this to be a miracle, stating that the statue wanted to stay in Zelaya. It remained in a small chapel for



forty years and was later purchased by Ana de Matos, who brought it to Luján. It still resides there in the Basilica of Our Lady of Luján, which began construction in 1887 and was completed in 1935. The Basilica was declared a National and Historical Monument in 1998. Millions visit there every year.

Pope John Paul II visited the shrine during his visit to Argentina. Many other Popes have honored Our Lady of Luján. Among them are Clement XI, Clement XIV, Pius VI, Pius IX, Leo XIII, Pius XI and Pius XII. In 1824, Father John Mastai Ferretti visited the shrine on his way to Chile. Years later he became Pope Pius IX, who defined the dogma of the Immaculate Conception on December 8, 1854.

In 1886, Pope Leo XIII decided to honor the shrine with a Canonical Coronation. That September, he blessed the crown, which was made of pure gold and set with three hundred sixty-five diamonds, emeralds, rubies, and sapphires. There is also one hundred thirty two pearls and many enamels, which depict the emblems of the Archbishop and the Argentine Republic.

The coronation of Our Lady of Luján took place on May 8, 1887. The celebrant was Archbishop Federico León Aneiros. He had made a pilgrimage to thank Our Lady for sparing his archdiocese from cholera.

On September 8, 1930, Pope Pius XI declared Our Lady of Luján as the Patroness of Argentina, Paraguay, and Uruguay. This was signed by Cardinal Eugenio Pacelli, the future Pope Pius XII. He was also the Papal Legate to the XXXII International Eucharistic Congress, which was held in Buenos Aires in October of 1934. He then visited the Basilica on October 15.

When Cardinal Pacelli became Pope Pius XII, he gave a radio address to the pilgrims in Luján on the day of the First Marian Congress in Argentina in 1947.

The Falklands War between Argentina and England began on April 2, 1982, and ended on June 14. Pope John Paul II went to Argentina on June 11. During this visit, he celebrated an outdoor Mass in the square of the Basilica. There, he bestowed a Golden Rose on the statue. The Golden Rose is a gift from a pope to countries, cities, basilicas, or images. He blesses the rose on the fourth Sunday of Lent, anointing it with Holy Chrism and then incense. The rose has a golden stem with flowers, buds, and leaves. It is put in a silver vase lined inside with a bronze case bearing the Papal shield. This tradition was started by Pope Leo IX in 1049.

Pope John Paul reflected on his trip, both in his homily of June 11 and then during his Angelus back in Rome, where he commented that Our Lady always gives maternal solicitude to the faithful in times of distress. Sixteen years later in Rome, John Paul II gave a replica of the statue to the Argentine National Parish during his visit there.

The feast day of Our Lady of Luján is May 8.
