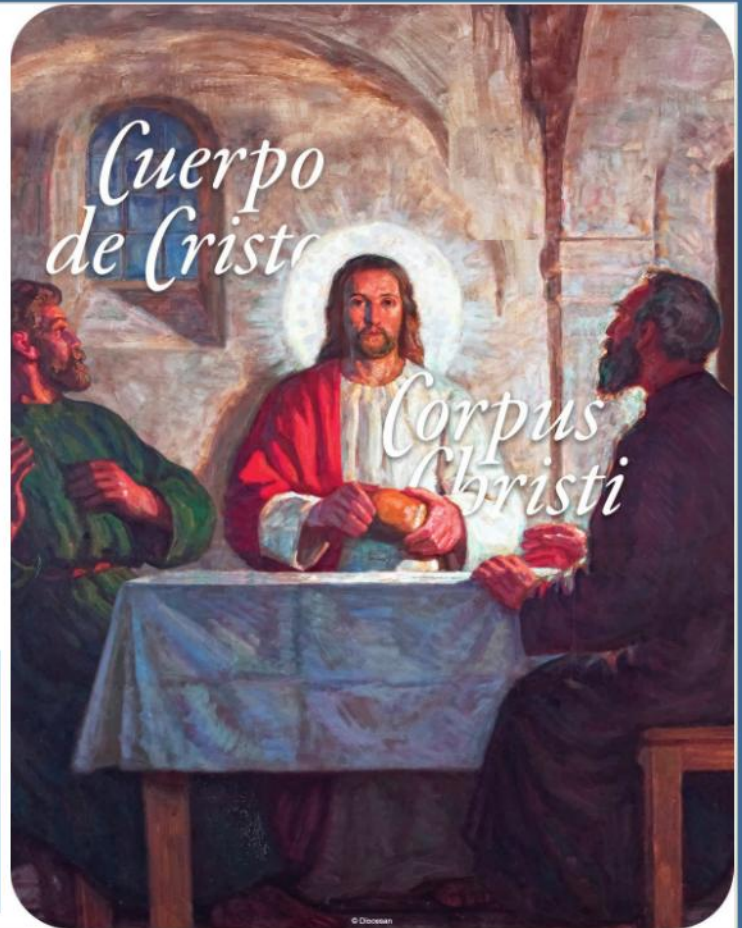

A Message From Father Carlos / Un Mensaje de Padre Carlos

Mi querida familia de Santa Faustina,

Este fin de semana celebramos la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Jesús, para darnos vida, se hace presente en medio de nosotros cada vez que nos reunimos en el gesto que Él mismo nos dejó la noche antes de Su entrega, en la Última Cena. En la Eucaristía, Él se nos da como alimento, en cuerpo, sangre, alma y divinidad para que vivamos siempre unidos a Él y aprendamos a amar como Él nos ha amado.

La muerte de Jesús no pudo romper nuestra comunión con Él. Sus discípulos, ni nosotros, nos quedamos solos. En el centro de toda comunidad Cristiana que celebra la Eucaristía está Cristo vivo. Aquí está el secreto de nuestra fuerza. De Él se alimenta nuestra fe. Ninguna otra experiencia nos puede ofrecer alimento más sólido. Su cuerpo entregado y Su sangre derramada, ha sido para nuestra salvación.

Nada hay más central y decisivo para los seguidores de Jesús que la celebración de esta Cena del Señor. Por eso es importantísimo cada semana vivir la Eucaristía. Si celebramos como se debe la Eucaristía, moldea y configura nuestra vida a Jesús, nos va uniendo a Jesús, nos alimenta de Su vida, nos familiariza con el Evangelio, nos invita a vivir en actitud de servicio fraterno, y nos sostiene en la esperanza del reencuentro final con Él. Hermanos y hermanas, ya es hora de entender y comprender que la Eucaristía no es una obligación, más bien es una necesidad. Como el cuerpo necesita el agua, el aire y el alimento; nuestra Alma necesita de Jesús Eucaristía. Jesús te espera siempre en la Eucaristía. ¡Ánimo!

My dear St. Faustina's family,

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus, to give us life, makes Himself present in our midst every time we gather in the gesture that He left us the night before He gave Himself to us at the Last Supper. In the Eucharist, He gives Himself to us as food, body, blood, soul, and divinity so that we may always live united to Him and learn to love as He has loved us.

The death of Jesus could not break our communion with him. His disciples, nor we, are left alone. The living Christ is at the center of every Christian community that celebrates the Eucharist. Here is the secret of our strength: He nourishes our faith. No other experience can offer us more solid nourishment. His body given and His blood poured out have been for our salvation.

Nothing is more central and decisive for the followers of Jesus than the celebration of this Lord's Supper. That is why it is so important to live the Eucharist every week. Suppose we celebrate the Eucharist as we should. In that case, it molds and configures our lives to Jesus, it unites us to Jesus, it nourishes us with His life, it familiarizes us with the Gospel, it invites us to live in an attitude of fraternal service, and it sustains us in the hope of the final reunion with Him. Brothers and sisters, it is time to understand and realize that the Eucharist is not an obligation but a necessity. As the body needs water, air, and food, our Soul needs Jesus the Eucharist. Jesus is always waiting for you in the Eucharist. Courage!

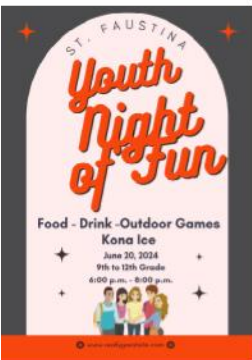

Servant of God Thea Bowman

Thea Bowman was a black Catholic religious sister, teacher, musician, liturgist, and scholar who made major contributions to Catholic African Americans. She was part of the civil rights movement, had a brilliant mind, a beautiful voice and a dynamic personality.

Bertha Elizabeth Bowman was born on December 29, 1937, in Yazoo City, Mississippi. Her grandfather Edward Bowman was a slave, but her father, Theon Edward Bowman was a doctor and her mother, Mary Esther Coleman was a teacher. Her family were Methodists, but at the age of nine, Thea became a Catholic with her parent's permission. She attended Holy Child Jesus School in Canton. When she was fifteen, she joined the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration in La Crosse, Wisconsin, despite her parents' objections. Later on, Thea attended Viterbo University, which was run by her congregation and earned a B.A. in English in 1965. Then, she went to Catholic University in Washington, D.C., earning an M.A. in English in 1969 and a Ph.D. in English in 1972. Her doctoral thesis was about St. Thomas More.

Thea taught at an elementary school in La Crosse and at Holy Child Jesus Catholic School, her alma mater. She later taught at her other alma maters, Viterbo College and Catholic University of America and then at Xavier University in New Orleans. After she had spent sixteen years in education, the Bishop of Jackson in Mississippi invited Sister Thea to become a consultant for intercultural awareness at his diocese.

Here she became directly involved with a ministry to her fellow African Americans. She began to give inspirational talks to black congregations, who welcomed her. She brought her "ministry of joy" to everyone she met. Sister Thea was heavily involved in the publication of a new Catholic hymnal, *Lead Me, Guide Me: The African American Catholic Hymnal*, the first such work directed to the black community. James P. Lyke, Auxiliary Bishop of Cleveland, also an African American, coordinated the hymnal project. Sister selected many hymns to be included. One was her essay, "The Gift of African American Sacred Song." In it, she wrote, "Black sacred song is soulful song."

She was a popular speaker on faith and spirituality in her final years, recorded music and helped found the National Black Sisters' Conference to provide support for African American women in Catholic religious life.

Sister Thea was diagnosed with breast cancer in 1984. She then began rigorous treatments but still maintained a heavy speaking schedule, praying "to live until I die." Her prayers were answered, with Sister Thea going to her gatherings in a wheelchair. Even as her illness progressed, her fame grew. She made several overseas trips sponsored by friends, including to West Africa and Lourdes. She also became famous in the media, appearing on national news outlets and being filmed for a documentary on her life after her terminal diagnosis.

In 1989, shortly before her death, she was awarded an honorary Doctorate in Religion by Boston College in recognition of her contributions to the Church. Also, the Sister Thea Bowman Black Catholic Educational Foundation was established to raise scholarship money for underserved students of color who sought post-secondary education but did not have the capability to attend. This was an effort which Sister saw as key to helping black people. Her vision was brought to life by founder Mary Lou Jennings under the guidance and direction of Sister Thea. By 2015, more than one hundred fifty African American students attended college through this program.

Sister Thea died of cancer on March 30, 1990. The Diocese of Jackson opened her cause for sainthood in 2018, and she was designated a Servant of God.

In 2015, Boston College instituted the Thea Bowman AHANA and Intercultural Center (African, Hispanic, Asian, Native American) and inaugurated an annual Thea Bowman Legacy Day.
