PASTOR'S MESSAGE / MENSAJE DEL PASTOR

Then he said to the crowd, "Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions." (Lk. 12:15)

For first-century Jews, there was no consensus and no defined doctrine of resurrection - no accepted understanding of how God would punish evil or reward good. Instead, many looked for God's approval or disapproval in this life: Those who lived long lives, and had material blessings and lots of children, were seen as favored by God, while those who had little were seen as less favored.

From the very beginning, we see the rich man as misled by the accumulation of wealth. Far from living in God's favor, he is actually deaf to God's voice; in fact, the only voice he hears is his own and it is full of self-concern and materialism. See how he refers to himself eight times - six times in the first person, and twice in the second - clearly his heart lies with his possessions.

We cannot commit to living as God wants and then try to hedge our bets at the altar of materialism. Instead, before the reality of death we are asked to put our trust firmly in God. We are called, in the words of today's psalm, to listen to God's voice so that his gracious care may be ours throughout our lives.

Brothers and sisters: If you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. (Col 3:1-3)

Luego dijo a la multitud: "Cuídense de protegerse contra toda codicia, porque, aunque uno pueda ser rico, su vida no consiste en posesiones". (Lc. 12:15)

Para los judíos del primer siglo, no había consenso ni doctrina definida de la resurrección, ni comprensión aceptada de cómo Dios castigaría el mal o recompensaría el bien. En cambio, muchos buscaron la aprobación o desaprobación de Dios en esta vida: Aquellos que vivieron largas vidas, y tuvieron bendiciones materiales y muchos hijos, fueron vistos como favorecidos por Dios, mientras que aquellos que tenían poco fueron vistos como menos favorecidos.

Desde el principio, vemos al hombre rico como engañado por la acumulación de riqueza. Lejos de vivir en el favor de Dios, en realidad es sordo a la voz de Dios; de hecho, la única voz que escucha es la suya y está llena de preocupación y materialismo. Vea cómo se refiere a sí mismo ocho veces, seis veces en primera persona y dos veces en la segunda, claramente su corazón está en sus posesiones.

No podemos comprometernos a vivir como Dios quiere y luego tratar de cubrir nuestras apuestas en el altar del materialismo. En cambio, ante la realidad de la muerte se nos pide que pongamos nuestra confianza firmemente en Dios. Estamos llamados, en las palabras del salmo de hoy, a escuchar la voz de Dios para que su cuidado misericordioso sea nuestro a lo largo de nuestras vidas.

Hermanos y hermanas: Si fueron criados con Cristo, busquen lo que está arriba, donde Cristo está sentado a la diestra de Dios. Piensa en lo que está arriba, no en lo que hay en la tierra. Porque has muerto, y tu vida está escondida con Cristo en Dios. (Col 3:1-3)

The Sacrament of Holy Baptism



The sacrament of Holy Baptism is usually scheduled for the third weekend of each month on Sunday at 12 noon. Baptismal Preparation Classes are typically scheduled for the third Thursday of each month at 5:30 pm. The Baptismal Preparation Class is required for first-time parents or if there is no record of a previous

class. A Baptismal date cannot be scheduled before registration for the preparation class is scheduled. Class space is limited, so please plan ahead.

The Sacrament of Holy Matrimony




The sacrament of Holy Matrimony is a serious commitment not to be taken lightly or unadvisedly. It typically takes 6-12 months to complete the required and proper preparation for marriage. Therefore, if this sacrament is a consideration, please contact our office approximately one year in advance and before wedding plans and a date are set.


Convalidations: If you are Catholic and married civilly and would like your marriage recognized by the Catholic Church, the process of receiving the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony is approximately a 6-month process. Please plan ahead and contact our office for more information.

El sacramento del Santo Matrimonio es un compromiso serio que no debe tomarse a la ligera o desaconsejadamente. Por lo general, toma de 6 a 12 meses completar la preparación requerida y adecuada para el matrimonio. Convalidaciones: Si usted es católico y está casado civilmente y desea que su matrimonio sea reconocido por la Iglesia Católica, el proceso de recibir el Sacramento del Santo Matrimonio es aproximadamente un proceso de 6 meses. 
ST. CHRISTOPHER

St. Christopher is one of the most popular saints in the Church. Many people carry his medals or have them in their cars because he is the patron saint of travelers, but not a lot is known about him. No one knows where he was born or much about his early life. There are many stories and traditions that he was tall and

strong, a man of great physical stature. One story said that Christopher wanted to serve the greatest king he could, so he went to a ruler to enter service, but he noticed that the king crossed himself at the mention of satan, so he decided that the devil had more power. Then he decided to serve the devil and met a group of thieves, whose leader referred to himself as the devil. Then this leader avoided a Christian cross out of fear, so Christopher learned that there was someone even more powerful than the devil. Soon he found a hermit who taught him all about Jesus. The hermit told Christopher that he should spend his life in prayer and fasting, a thing which he rejected, so the hermit suggested that Christopher find something else to do.

This led Christopher to work at a nearby river, helping travelers go across. The waters were dangerous and many people drowned. The hermit told Christopher that helping people would please Christ. One day, a child came to the river and asked to be helped across. Christopher obliged, but as he entered midstream, the river rose and the child's weight grew and became very heavy. It took a lot of work, but Christopher safely delivered the child to the other side. He asked the child why he was so heavy and the child explained that He was Jesus. When Christopher carried Him, he also carried the weight of the whole world on his shoulders. Then the child disappeared.



St. Christopher did not become popular in the Church until the seventh century, hundreds of years after his death. History mentions this popularity because around the seventh century, churches and monasteries began to be named after him. St. Christopher is one of the most famous Catholic and Christian heroes of the Faith and his name is one of the most popular names in the world, always in the top 50% of names for boys.

There is also speculation that St. Christopher could have been confused with St. Menas, an Egyptian saint. Both St. Christopher and St. Menas are referred to as "Christ bearers" and are patrons of travelers. The name Christopher comes from the Greek word Christóforos, which means "bearer of Christ." It is has two Greek elements Christós (Christ) and phero (to bear or carry). St. Christopher is not officially recognized by the Church, so there is no date of beatification or canonization. But despite these technicalities, it is widely believed that he was real and that he continues to intercede on behalf of Christians, especially children.

St. Christopher is the patron saint of children, bachelors, transportation, traveling, surfing, storms, gardeners, holy death, athletes, mariners, ferryman, epilepsy, toothaches, St. Christopher's Island, also known as St. Kitts and Havana, Cuba.

His feast day is July 25.


