PASTOR'S MESSAGE / MENSAJE DEL PASTOR

And he said to them, "Why were you looking for me? Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?" But they did not understand what he said to them. He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them; and his mother kept all these things in her heart. And Jesus advanced in wisdom and age and favor before God and man.(Lk 2:50-52)

The beginning of today's Gospel states that Mary and Joseph went to Jerusalem annually for Passover *according to festival custom*. On one such occasion, when Christ was 12, he remained at the temple; his parents found him there, discussing Scriptures with the rabbis. Significantly, this story of finding him in the temple "is the only event that breaks the silence of the Gospels about the hidden years of Jesus"(Catechism, 534).

These visits to a house of worship are significant. The temple in Jerusalem was seen as God's dwelling place. Even Jesus - God's dwelling place among men - took the time to go there(Catechism, 586). The temple was a house of prayer, where sacrifices were offered and God's praises were sung. At the temple, in the synagogues, and in his home, a young Jesus would have learned the words and rhythms of his people's prayers.

Like Jesus, Mary and Joseph, we are part of a holy family - we, too, are *children of God*. Just like Mary and Joseph, our family life is enriched when we go to church to worship the One who created and loves us. Like Mary and Joseph, we must be attentive to the presence of Christ in our lives, to hold all he did and said in our hearts, and to willingly participate in God's divine plan. By being attentive to God's word and by keeping his commandments, we, too, will grow in wisdom and grace and favor.

Those who keep his commandments remain in him, and he in them, and the way we know that he remains in us is from the Spirit he gave us.(1John 3:24)

El les dijo: "¿Por qué me buscabais? ¿No sabíais que yo debía estar en la casa de mi Padre?" Pero ellos no comprendieron la respuesta que les dio. Bajó con ellos y vino a Nazaret, y vivía sujeto a ellos. Su madre conservaba cuidadosamente todas las cosas en su corazón. Jesús progresaba en sabiduría, en estatura y en gracia ante Dios y ante los hombres. (Lc 2:49-52)

El comienzo del Evangelio de hoy dice que María y José iban anualmente a Jerusalén para la Pascua de acuerdo con la costumbre de la fiesta. En una de esas ocasiones, cuando Cristo tenía 12 años, permaneció en el templo; sus padres lo encontraron allí, discutiendo las Escrituras con los rabinos. Es significativo que esta historia de encontrarlo en el templo "es el único acontecimiento que rompe el silencio de los Evangelios sobre los años ocultos de Jesús" (Catecismo, 534).

Estas visitas a una casa de culto son significativas. El templo de Jerusalén fue visto como la morada de Dios. Incluso Jesús, la morada de Dios entre los hombres, se tomó el tiempo de ir allí (Catecismo, 586). El templo era una casa de oración, donde se ofrecían sacrificios y se cantaban alabanzas a Dios. En el templo, en las sinagogas y en su casa, un joven Jesús habría aprendido las palabras y los ritmos de las oraciones de su pueblo.

Como Jesús, María y José, somos parte de una sagrada familia; nosotros también somos hijos de Dios. Al igual que María y José, nuestra vida familiar se enriquece cuando vamos a la iglesia a adorar a Aquel que nos creó y nos ama. Como María y José, debemos estar atentos a la presencia de Cristo en nuestras vidas, para mantener todo lo que Él hizo y dijo en nuestro oración y para participar voluntariamente en el plan divino de Dios. Si estamos atentos a la palabra de Dios y guardamos sus mandamientos, también nosotros crecemos en sabiduría, gracia y favor.

Quien guarda sus mandamientos permanece en Dios y Dios en él; en esto conocemos que permanece en nosotros: por el Espíritu que nos dio. (1Juan 3:24)

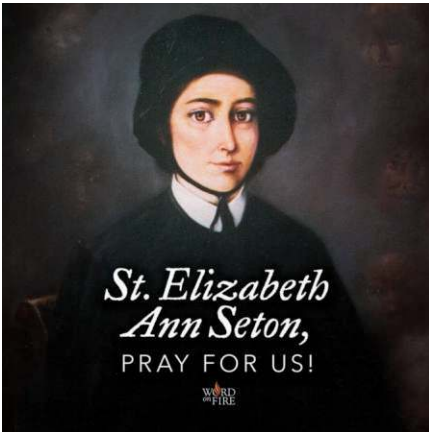

ST. ELIZABETH ANN SETON

Elizabeth Ann Bayley was the second child of Dr. Richard Bayley and Catherine Charlton, a socially upward couple. She was born on August 28, 1774 in Manhattan but lost her Mother three years later. Her father soon married Charlotte Barclay. The family attended the Episcopal Church, stressing charity and visiting the poor to give food and other needed items. Her parents now had five children, but then separated, causing Richard to go to England. Charlotte rejected Elizabeth and her sister, leaving the girls in the care of their aunt and uncle. For Elizabeth, this was a time of grieving, which she wrote about in her journals, along with a love of reading, poetry, music, nature and religious thoughts. She was an accomplished musician and equestrian who also spoke French.

When Elizabeth was nineteen, she married William Magee Seton, a wealthy businessman. She continued her charitable ways, becoming a member and then the treasurer in 1798 of the Society for the Relief of Poor Widows with

Small Children. Elizabeth and William raised his six siblings when his father died, along with their five children. Eventually William's company was in trouble and bankruptcy followed causing the family to move in with Elizabeth's father. Her husband had tuberculosis, which was now worsened by the events, so he, Elizabeth and their eldest daughter, Anna Maria went to Italy for a milder climate, where he died in 1803. Then Elizabeth and Anna Maria went to live with William's Italian business partner and his family, who introduced Elizabeth to Catholicism. She was twenty nine. Her faith in the will of God would guide her throughout her life. She called it "The Will."

When they returned to New York, Elizabeth was baptized on March 14, 1804 and received her Confirmation a year later, taking the name Mary because of her devotion to the Blessed Mother. Elizabeth had started an academy for young women but lost a number of students because she was now a Catholic. She met Father Louis Dubourge and accepted his offer to establish a Catholic school in Emmitsburg MD called St. Joseph's Academy and Free School for Girls. She also started a religious community at Emmitsburg for the care of poor children. Elizabeth and eighteen other women took their vows on July 19, 1813. This was the first religious order founded in the US and the first free Catholic school. They were called the Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph and Elizabeth was now called Mother Seton.

Elizabeth spent the rest of her life leading and working with the congregation. In 1814, the community started an orphanage in Philadelphia and then created one in New York in 1817. She died on January 4, 1821 at age forty six and is buried at the National Shrine of St. Elizabeth Seton in Emmitsburg.

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton was venerated by Pope John XXIII in 1959, beatified by Pope John Paul XXIII on March 17, 1963 and canonized by Paul VI on September 14, 1975.

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton is the first native born American to become a saint and is the patron saint of Catholic schools, grief, widows, in-law problems, death of children, death of parents, opposition of Church authorities and seafarers. She was also inducted into the National Women's Hall of Fame. Some of her symbols are a pink flower, a Rosary, a Bible, wheat and schools. Her feast day is January 4.

At her beatification, Pope John said "In a house that was very small, but with ample space for charity, she sowed a seed in America which by Divine Grace grew into a large tree."

When she was canonized, Pope Paul stated that " Elizabeth Ann Seton is a saint. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton is an American. All of us say this with special joy and with the intention of honoring the land and the nation from which she sprang forth as the first flower in the calendar of the saints. Elizabeth Ann Seton was wholly American! Rejoice for your glorious daughter. Be proud of her. And know how to preserve her fruitful heritage."
