Faith Formation, 2023-24

We are celebrating our one year anniversary in our new church this week.

Last year, there were one hundred fifty six students, children and adults, in our program. They had an extra two weeks off between Glenbrook and the new church. There were dozens of boxes to pack and unpack. When we started to set up classrooms, parents and teachers organized the cabinets and drawers. Many thanks to them for this endeavor. Classes resumed and we finished the semester with sacraments and end of year parties.

Registration in August brought an enrollment of two hundred thirty seven students.

Classrooms are packed, but even with the limited space, teachers have been creative with projects in addition to their books. We started a Youth Group with great attendance. The young people had a table at the Ministry Fair, made ornaments, which they sold before Christmas and donated the funds to the church debt fund and helped with all kinds of volunteer situations. Maggie San Filippo, Angela Francisco and Kim Tettemer are the Youth Group leaders, with assistance from Toni Jean and Reynold Franco, Cristina Lopez and Dr. Eulalia Sentino. We have more projects and outings planned for them.

The Kindergarten children and grades one and two participated in the Christmas Pageant in December. This year we upgraded the costumes, donated by sixth grade teacher Angela Francisco.

All children have to attend Circle of Grace classes once a year, which teaches safety and addresses the world we live in. Also this year we have added additional classes for Catechumen children and RCIA Candidate teens. Twelve students, adults and teen Catecumen, will be receiving their sacraments at the Easter Vigil on March 30. We have a special Sacramental prep class for older students making their First Communion. Thirty students made their First Confession on January 20, with ten more to complete before First Communion day.

On May 12, forty children and adults will receive their First Communion. Thirty five teens and adults will be confirmed on June 15.

Thanks to all of our teachers for their dedication - Diana Gomez and Annette Calcagno (Kindergarten), Toni and Reynold Franco (1), Cristina Lopez (2) and Dr. Eulalia Sentino (2 and Circle of Grace), Giovana Caracole Souza and Cibele De Jesus Sena Camalionte (3), Ella Pingalore (4 and Circle of Grace), George Cuttita (5), Angela Francisco (6, Circle of Grace and Youth Group Leader), Tina Pingalore (7 and Circle of Grace), Maggie San Filippo (8, Circle of Grace and Youth Group Leader), Connie Stoops (Confirmation), Israel Santiago (RCIA Adults), Mary Lou Cavallini/Odila Cordeiro (RCIA/Children Catechumen), Josephine Pantina (RCIA/Teen Candidates, Sacramental Prep and Circle of Grace), Kim Tettemer (Substitute teacher and Youth Group Leader), Stefani Francisco (Substitute teacher) and Susan Green (Circle of Grace).

We also thank the hall monitors, along with teachers, who ensure safety. Cecilia Rivera, Patrick Crisostomo and Namdar Hosseinzadeh assist in this area.

Everyone is looking forward to years to come. We are very blessed to work with all of the teachers, children and parents. It is very gratifying to see the children come back each year with many young people all grown up and volunteering in different ministries, especially since we are in our new home.
