A Message From Father Carlos / Un Mensaje de Padre Carlos

My dear family of St. Faustina,

“In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” With these words, we always begin our Eucharistic celebration. Also, with this invocation begins our Christian life, our life as children of God: “I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” Our whole life is filled with the presence of God, the center of our faith- the God who is the origin and source of life and love. But it is a mystery that shows him to be close to us instead of distancing God from us. He is so close that he reveals himself to be present and active in us through Jesus Christ, our Lord.

Brothers and sisters, we know that the password of the Christian is the “sign of the cross .”For it is in the cross of Christ that the Trinitarian mystery is revealed to us in fullness. It is in his self-giving unto death that Jesus reveals to us the immense and eternal love of the Son for the Father, who loves him and sustains him in his sacrifice until he gives him triumph over evil and death and seats him at his right hand in glory, in the mutual gift of the Holy Spirit, the personification of God’s eternal love.

Each Sunday in our celebration, we say together, “I believe in one God...” and in that prayer, we manifest our faith in the Triune God. We believe in the loving and creative action of the Father, the liberating and saving action of the Son, and the sanctifying and fulfilling action of the Spirit. This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, which helps us to contemplate the paschal mystery in its totality, in the action of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. It also reveals to us the being of the Christian image and likeness of a God who is a community of life, a community of love, and a communion of persons. The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity invites us to mature the community of faith, foster unity in charity, and develop the mission in the hope of fullness.

I invite you to reflect this week on the following question: Does the Trinitarian God influence our Christian life? Take heart!

St. Joan of Arc

Jeanne d'Arc was born in 1412 to a peasant family in Domrémy, France. Her birthday is believed to be January 6. Joan's parents were Jacques d'Arc and Isabelle Romée, who also had three sons and another daughter. Her father was a peasant farmer who owned around fifty acres of land, supplementing his income as a village official. He collected taxes and headed the local watch. As a child, Jeanne did household chores, helped with spinning wool, worked in the fields, and looked after the animals. Her mother was her religious education teacher.

Jeanne's birth occurred during the Hundred Years' War between England and France, which had begun in 1337. The fight was over the status of English territories in France and English claims to the French throne. The English and their allies dominated much of France, including Paris, Bordeaux and Reims.

France was divided politically. French King Charles VI had constant bouts of mental illness and couldn't rule. His brother Louis was the Duke of Orléans and his cousin John the Fearless was the Duke of Burgundy. Both quarreled about ruling France. In 1407, John ordered the assassination of Louis, causing a civil war which devastated the economy. Supporters of the Duke of Burgundy were called "Burgundians." Much of Domrémy was surrounded by pro-Burgundian factions, but most people were loyal to the Armagnac cause, headed by Louis.

By 1419, the war had totally affected the area. In 1425, Domrémy was attacked and their cattle were stolen which led villagers to see that the English had to be expelled from France to achieve peace. Joan had her first vision after this. Charles of Orléans was the Dauphin, the heir apparent. He succeeded his father as Duke at the age of thirteen and was placed in the custody of Bernard, Count of Armagnac. Charles then became the heir to the throne and was associated with the Armagnacs.

In 1428, Joan asked to see Charles. She said that she was guided by visions of St. Michael the Archangel, St. Margaret of Antioch, and St. Catherine of Alexandria, who told her that she needed to help Charles save France from an English invasion. She was only sixteen, but Charles could see her devotion and goodness. He sent Joan to Orléans in the relief army. She arrived there in April of 1429. Nine days later, the English Army gave up the siege. She then wanted to pursue the English at the Loire Campaign. This gave way to the victory at Patay, which allowed the French to advance on to Reims. With Joan beside him, Charles' armies expelled the English and Burgundians from the Loire Valley, taking back Troyes and liberating Reims, the traditional coronation site for French monarchs. Here, Charles was crowned King of France.

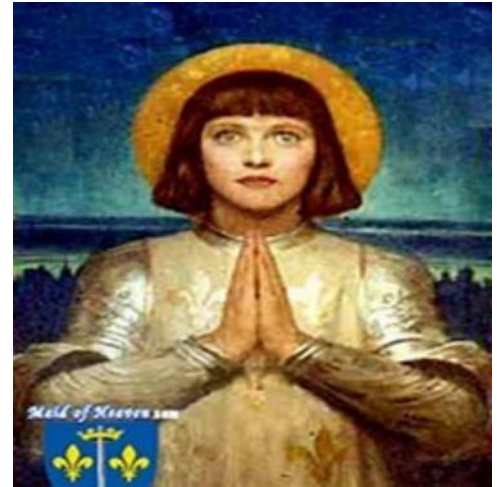
After the coronation, Joan was unsuccessful at the siege of Paris in 1429 and then failed to capture La Charité. These defeats caused everyone to lose faith in her.

In 1430, Joan organized volunteers to save Compiègne, but was captured on May 23 by Burgundian troops, who were the French allies of the English. She tried to escape, but was eventually brought to the British camp.

Bishop Pierre Cauchon oversaw her trial regarding accusations of heresy, which included charges of blasphemy because she wore men's clothes, acted upon visions that were considered demonic, and for refusing to align her words and actions to the judgment of the Church. For this, Joan was declared guilty and burned at the stake on May 30, 1431, when she was nineteen.

In 1456, an inquisitorial court reinvestigated Joan's trial. Her verdict was overturned, and the court declared that her trial was overridden by deceit and procedural errors. Since this time, Joan has been revered as a martyr, viewed as an obedient daughter of the Church and an early feminist, who represented freedom and independence. She became the national symbol of France after the French Revolution, declared by Napoleon in 1830.

St. Joan of Arc was canonized in 1920 and two years later was declared the patron saint of France. Her feast day is May 30.
