A Message From Father Carlos / Un Mensaje de Padre Carlos

My dear family of St. Faustina,

Today is the Twelfth Sunday of Ordinary Time. The Word of God invites us to renew our faith in God's goodness, wisdom, and omnipotence. He is the creator of all and has dominion over all. We must have faith and always seek our joy in the Lord.

In the first reading, taken from the Book of Job, we see that God's beneficent hand is found in everything, for example, in the storm. God's dominion over the sea is a symbol and reminder of divine omnipotence. God wants Job to hope and trust in him. In the second reading, St. Paul says that, through the death and resurrection of Christ, we and the world are a new creation. So, our way of living must be according to the Spirit and not according to the flesh. The experience of encountering Christ has made Paul completely change his way of thinking and acting, no longer according to human criteria. And by what criteria do we allow ourselves to be led? Do we live according to the Spirit?

In the Gospel, the scene of the storm while Jesus sleeps reminds us that He never abandons us, even if He seems to be asleep. He promised to guide the boat of his Church to a good port despite the adversities. Jesus commands us not to be afraid and to trust him completely: even in the face of the greatest tribulations, his voice and gestures always have the power to calm the storm and bring the necessary peace. How much confidence and faith do we have in this Jesus who does not abandon us? Courage!

Mi querida familia de Santa Faustina,

Estamos en el Domingo duodécimo del Tiempo Ordinario. La Palabra de Dios hoy nos invita a renovar nuestra fe en la bondad, sabiduría y omnipotencia de Dios, Él es creador de todo y tiene dominio, sobre todo. Hay que tener Fe y buscar nuestra alegría en el Señor en todo momento.

La primera lectura, tomada del Libro de Job, vemos que la mano benefactora de Dios se encuentra en todo; por ejemplo, en la tempestad. El dominio de Dios sobre el mar es símbolo y recuerdo de la omnipotencia divina. Dios quiere que Job espere y confíe en Él. En la segunda lectura, San Pablo dice que, por la muerte y resurrección de Cristo, nosotros y el mundo somos una nueva creación. Entonces, nuestra manera de vivir debe ser según el Espíritu y no según la carne. La experiencia de encuentro con Cristo ha hecho que Pablo cambie por completo su forma de pensar y de actuar, ya no más criterios humanos. Y nosotros, ¿Por cuales criterios nos dejamos llevar? ¿Vivimos según el Espíritu?

En el Evangelio la escena de la tempestad mientras Jesús duerme, nos recuerda que Él nunca nos abandona, aunque parezca dormido. Él prometió guiar la barca de su Iglesia a buen puerto, a pesar de las adversidades. Jesús nos exhorta a no tener miedo, a fiarnos plenamente de Él: aún ante las mayores tribulaciones, su voz y su gesto siempre tienen el poder de calmar la tormenta y hacer llegar la paz necesaria. ¿Cuánta confianza y fe tenemos en ese Jesús que no nos abandona?

The Nativity of St. John the Baptist

Only three people have had their births recorded in the New Testament. They are Christ, Blessed Mother Mary and St. John the Baptist.

St. John is long associated with the coming of Jesus and the circumstances of Christ's birth. His place in the gospel emphasizes the announcement of his birth and the event itself, both parallel to Jesus. They were cousins. One biblical account of the birth of John the Baptist comes from the Gospel of Luke. His parents were a Jewish priest named Zechariah and his wife Elizabeth was Mary's

cousin, who were elderly and childless. Zechariah's rotation to serve in the Temple in Jerusalem caused him to be chosen by lot to offer incense at the Golden Altar in the Holy Place. Here, the Archangel Gabriel appeared to him and announced that he and Elizabeth would give birth to a child and call him John, which was a unfamiliar name in their families.

Zechariah did not believe the message of Gabriel, so he became speechless until the time of his son's birth. Then, his relatives wanted to name the child after him, but Zechariah wrote, "*His name is John.*" Now he could talk once again as well as having received the gift of prophecy, speaking of the future ministry of Jesus. This prophecy formed the text of the Benedictus canticle, which can be found in Luke 1:57-79, along with the news of the birth of John.

At the Annunciation, the angel Gabriel appeared to Mary to tell her that she would conceive a child by the Holy Spirit and that Elizabeth was already six months pregnant. Mary went to visit Elizabeth, who was overjoyed by both situations and said that her baby "leapt" in her womb at the greeting of Mary. As an adult, Jesus called John the greatest of all those who had preceded him, saying, "I tell you, among those born of women, no one is greater than John."

When John was older he spent his time in the desert as an ascetic, announcing the coming of the Kingdom and called everyone to atone which was to prepare the way for Christ. He said that his baptism was for repentance, but one would come who would baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire. John's attitude toward Jesus was that he was not worthy even to untie Christ's sandals. Yet Jesus was among those who were baptized saying "I need to be baptized by you."

The Nativity of John the Baptist occurred on June 24, three months after the celebration on March 25 of the Annunciation and six months before the birth of Jesus at Christmas. These dates are commemorated in an entwining way. John's nativity anticipates Christmas.

The Nativity of John the Baptist is one of the oldest feasts of the Christian church, being listed by the Council of Agde in the year 506 as one of that region's principal festivals. It was a day of rest and was celebrated with three Masses at the vigil, dawn and noon.

In Europe "Saint John's fires" are lit on the mountains and hilltops on the eve of his feast, closely associated with the summer solstice. Celebrated as the first day of summer, Saint John's Day is considered in one of the great "charmed" festivals of the year. Hidden treasures are placed in different areas for those to find. Tradition says that if herbs are plucked during the night of the feast, they are for healing. In Germany these are called "Johanneskraut" (St. John's herbs), where people bring them to church for a special blessing. In Scandinavia and in the Slavic countries, Saint John's Day is similar to Halloween.

El Dia de San Juan is celebrated in Tucson, Arizona, marking the beginning of the monsoon season. There is a legend that the Spanish explorer Francisco Vásquez de Coronado prayed for rain on June 24, 1540, and then it did rain.

Because John the Baptist cleansed the faithful of their sins in the Jordan River, people of Mexico and the American Southwest once stepped into the water following morning Mass on June 24. Most of these traditions have faded in Tucson in the last century but in 1998 the City of Tucson, in partnership with neighborhoods and private organizations, revived the tradition of "El Dia de San Juan."
