A Message From Father Carlos / Un Mensaje de Padre Carlos

Mi querida familia de Santa Faustina,

Las lecturas de este domingo nos hablan de la misión que todos nosotros como BAUTIZADOS tenemos y debemos cumplir para gloria y obra de Dios. Dios, nuestro Padre confía en nosotros y por eso nos envía a cumplir lo que nos ha encomendado. La Palabra nos habla de que somos elegidos y enviados. El profeta Amós fue elegido por el Señor y enviado para que usara su talento para el pueblo de Dios y en la segunda lectura, San Pablo nos recuerda que nosotros también somos elegidos.

El Evangelio cuenta la historia del envío de los doce discípulos. Jesús elige y envía a sus discípulos a una primera misión. Ellos son llamados a hacer presente el Reino de Dios, sin buscar nada a cambio. Cuando Jesús envía a sus discípulos a prolongar su misión, no piensa en lo que deben llevar consigo, sino precisamente en lo contrario: lo que no deben llevar.

El estilo de vida que les propone es tan desafiante que muy pronto las generaciones cristianas lo suavizaron. ¿Qué debemos hacer hoy con estas palabras de Jesús, borrarlas del evangelio, olvidarlas para siempre o hacerlas nuestras y cumplirlas?

Jesús imaginaba a sus seguidores de otra manera: liberados de ataduras, identificados con los últimos, con la confianza puesta totalmente en Dios, curando a los que sufren, sirviendo y entregándose a los demás. Esto no puede ser solo interpretado para los sacerdotes. Hermano y hermana, también a ti Jesús te llama y te envía. Es iluso pensar que el sacerdote puede con todo, no somos súper humanos ni extraterrestres. La misión es compartida y tenemos una responsabilidad compartida, TODOS. Sólo así la evangelización podrá llegar a todos los confines de la tierra. Reflexionemos: ¿Por qué he sido elegido? ¿A qué he sido enviado? ¿Estoy siendo fiel a la llamada de Dios? ¡Ánimo!

My dear family of St. Faustina,

This Sunday's readings speak to us of the mission that all of us as BAPTIZED have and must fulfill for the glory and work of God. God, our Father, trusts us, and that is why He sends us to fulfill what He has entrusted to us. The Word tells us that we are chosen and sent. The Lord chose the prophet Amos and sent him to use his talent for God's people.

In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us that we, too, are chosen.

The Gospel tells the story of the sending of the twelve disciples. Jesus chooses and sends his disciples on a first mission. They are called to make the Kingdom of God present without seeking anything in return. When Jesus sends his disciples to prolong their mission, he does not think about what they should take with them, but precisely the opposite: what they should not take.

The lifestyle he proposes to them is so challenging that very soon, the Christian generations watered it down. What should we do today with these words of Jesus, erase them from the Gospel, forget them forever, or make them our own and fulfill them?

Jesus envisioned his followers differently: freed from bondage, identified with the least of these, trusting totally in God, healing the suffering, serving, and giving themselves to others. This cannot be interpreted only for priests. Brother and sister, Jesus also calls you and sends you. It is an illusion to think that the priest can do everything; we are not superhumans or extraterrestrials. The mission is shared, and we have a shared responsibility, ALL of us. Only in this way can evangelization reach all the ends of the earth. Let us reflect: Why have I been chosen? What have I been sent to do? Am I being faithful to God's call, courage?

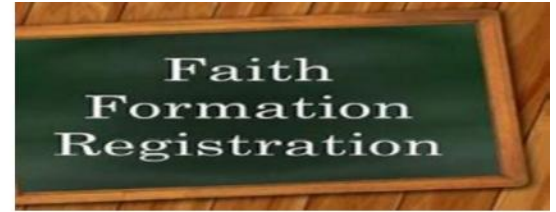

Servant of God Bernard John Quinn

Bernard John Quinn was born in Newark, NJ, on January 15, 1888. His parents were Bernard and Sara Quinn, who were poor Irish immigrants. His father was a longshoreman. There were also two brothers and four sisters. One sister became a Sister of St. Joseph in Watertown, NY. The family were members of St. Patrick's pro-cathedral in Newark, NJ. Later, they joined St. Michael's Parish. Bernard attended the St. Michael's elementary school where he cultivated his faith.

In 1906, he enrolled at St. John's Seminary and was ordained a priest on June 12, 1912. Initially, Father was assigned to different parishes on a temporary basis. He recognized that the black community was neglected by the Diocese and asked Charles McDonnell, the Brooklyn bishop about starting an "apostolate to Blacks." The bishop said no because he needed priests to serve in the war. Father then volunteered and was a chaplain for the 333rd Machine Gun Infantry in France during World War I, where he was gassed.

After the war ended, Father Bernard was in Alencon, France, the city where St. Thérèse grew up. He asked permission to visit her house and was the first priest to say Mass there before it became a shrine. He had a great devotion to St. Thérèse of Lisieux, asking her to help him in his mission. St. Thérèse was canonized on May 17, 1925. Father began having weekly novenas to her at the church, which attracted people from other parishes too. Many acknowledged that their prayers were answered due to the intercession of St. Thérèse.

When he came back to the US, Father went to Brooklyn NY, bought a former Protestant church, blessed it and named it St. Peter Claver. The church still stands today. Among its parishioners were Pearl Bailey and Lena Horne, who both sang in the children's choir.

In 1928, Father Bernard created the first orphanage in the Diocese for black children in Wading River, NY, in Suffolk County on Long Island. The center was called the Little Flower House of Providence, established for orphaned, abandoned, and neglected children. However, he received a great deal of opposition from many people about this. The next year, John L. Belford wrote a newsletter opposing the growing number of African Americans in the Catholic Church, to which Father Quinn responded, "No church can exclude anyone and still keep its Christian ideals."

The Ku Klux Klan burned the building twice, but then Father used fireproof materials to rebuild it. In 1929, an article appeared in The Brooklyn Daily Eagle with the headline: "New Fireproof Orphanage Will Defy Incendiary."

This center later became the base of operations for the Little Flower Children and Family Services of New York. It still provides many services, including care for adults with developmental disabilities, help for abused women, youth at-risk of out-of-home placement, critical health care and services which supports the well-being of all and more. These facilities serve people in Brooklyn, Queens and Long Island.

Now a monsignor, he also founded St. Benedict the Moor Church in Jamaica, New York, in 1932.

In April of 1940, Monsignor Quinn had an abdominal issue and was admitted to St. Mary's Hospital in Brooklyn for surgery. He died of stomach cancer at the age of fifty-two on April 7. Eight thousand people attended his funeral, and he was buried at St. Peter Claver church.

On June 24, 2010, Bishop Nicholas D. Marzio attended St. Peter Claver Church and officially opened the inquiry into the Cause of Canonization for Monsignor Bernard J. Quinn, who was granted the title of Servant of God. Now, the Vatican is investigating to elevate the Monsignor to Venerable.

Monsignor Paul Jervis, who is working on the case for the canonization, said "St. Peter Claver Catholic Church became a meeting ground where white Catholics encountered blacks and discovered that they all had a common humanity with the same human problems and were all in need of the intercession of St. Thérèse and the pastoral intercession of Monsignor Quinn."

Upon his canonization, Monsignor Bernard J. Quinn would be the first person from Brooklyn to become a saint.
