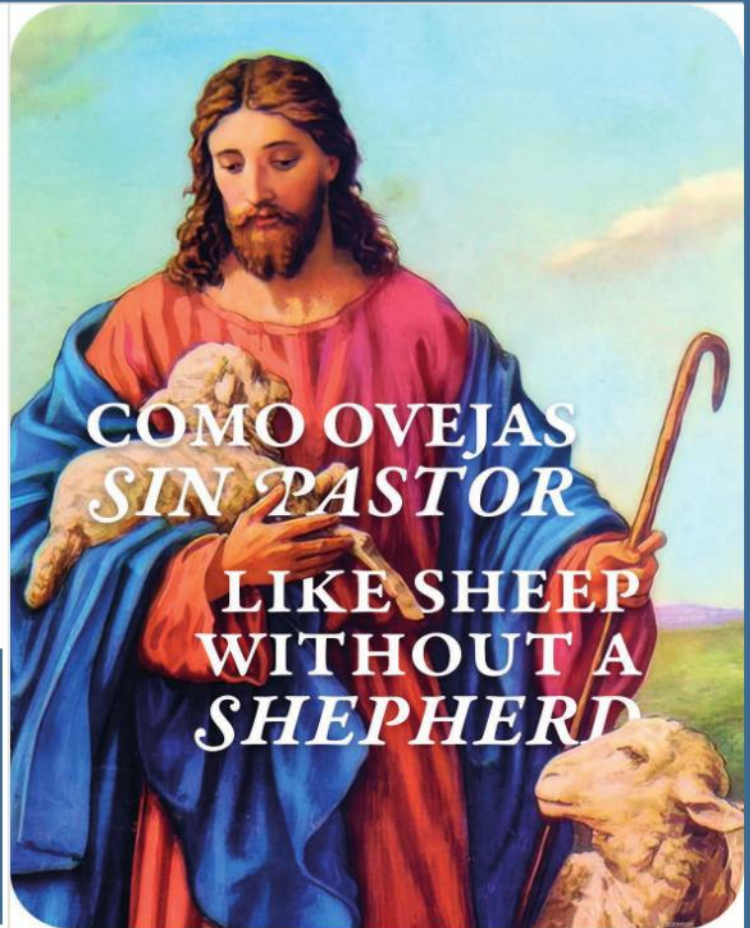

A Message From Father Carlos / Un Mensaje de Padre Carlos

My dear family of St. Faustina,

This Sunday's readings remind us of Jesus as the Good Shepherd and the responsibility of religious leaders and the community of believers to follow his teachings. It emphasizes that Jesus is the shepherd who gathers the stray sheep, providing teaching and spiritual guidance, in contrast to the criticism of the shepherds of Jeremiah's time, who failed to care for God's flock. Paul's second reading to the Ephesians underlines the greatness of Jesus as the promised Messiah, who brings unity and reconciliation between Jews and non-Jews, all under the action of the Holy Spirit. This is why building a community founded on the love of Christ is important.

Brothers and sisters, the word again reminds us that the mission of the Church is the task of all, priests and laity alike. The collaboration and prayer of the whole community are needed to fulfill this mission of bringing Christ's message of peace and love to the world. Let us not waste this great opportunity and reflect on how each of us can contribute to the common good of the Church on a personal and community level. Criticizing is easy, but being part of the solutions is more challenging. We have to work actively with the gifts and talents that God has given us.

Let us find moments of silence and tranquility to meet personally with Jesus, which is fundamental to finding the peace that He offers. Let us remember that this encounter with Jesus strengthens faith and enables believers to live as the Church that God wants. In summary, let us seek a personal relationship with Jesus and become aware of our shared responsibility in the mission of the Church and the importance of living the values of the Gospel in the community. It is not easy, but it is not impossible either, and it is certainly worth it. Courage!

Las lecturas de este domingo nos recuerdan la figura de Jesús como el Buen Pastor y la responsabilidad de los líderes religiosos y la comunidad de creyentes en seguir sus enseñanzas. Hace hincapié en que Jesús es el pastor que reúne a las ovejas descarriadas, proporcionando enseñanza y guía espiritual. Esto en contraste con la crítica hacia los pastores de la época de Jeremías, quienes no cumplieron con su deber de cuidar al rebaño de Dios. La segunda lectura de Pablo a los Efesios subraya la grandeza de Jesús como el Mesías prometido, quien trae unidad y reconciliación entre judíos y no judíos, todos bajo la acción del Espíritu Santo. Por eso es importante construir una comunidad fundamentada en el amor de Cristo.

Hermanos y hermanas, la palabra nuevamente nos recuerda que la misión de la Iglesia es tarea de todos, sacerdotes y laicos por igual. Se necesita la colaboración y la oración de toda la comunidad para cumplir con esta misión de llevar el mensaje de paz y amor de Cristo al mundo. No desaprovechemos esta gran oportunidad y reflexionemos a nivel personal y comunitario sobre cómo cada uno puede contribuir al bien común de la Iglesia. Criticar es fácil, pero ser parte de las soluciones, no es tan fácil. Tenemos que trabajar activamente con los dones y talentos que Dios ha dado.

Tratemos de buscar momentos de silencio y tranquilidad para encontrarnos personalmente con Jesús. Esto es fundamental para encontrar la paz que Él ofrece. Recordemos este encuentro con Jesús fortalece la fe y capacita a los creyentes para vivir como la Iglesia que Dios quiere. En resumen, busquemos la relación personal con Jesús, tomemos conciencia de la responsabilidad compartida en la misión de la Iglesia y la importancia de vivir los valores del Evangelio en comunidad. No es fácil pero tampoco es imposible y muy seguro que vale la pena. ¡Ánimo!

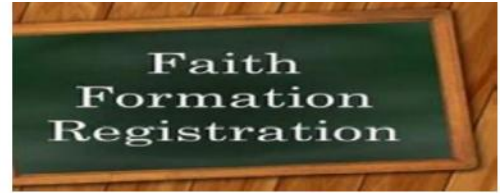

New Saints to be Canonized

The College of Cardinals met with Pope Francis in the Vatican's Apostolic Palace for an Ordinary Public Consistory on July 1. The Pope led the Mid-Morning Prayer of the Liturgy of the Hours before the Cardinals started to review the causes of canonization of several Blessed people. Cardinal Marcelo Semeraro, the Prefect of the Dicastery for the Causes of the Saints, presented a brief report regarding the lives and miracles of the fifteen people who are being considered. Then, the Consistory voted and approved their canonization.

The largest group of new Saints were martyred as they prayed inside the Franciscan church in Damascus, Syria, on July 9, 1860. They are called the **"Martyrs of Damascus."** These holy men are Father Manuel Ruiz López, OFM, his seven companions, Carmelo Bolta, Nicanor Ascanio, Nicolás M. Alberca y Torres, Pedro Soler, Engelbert Kolland, Francisco Pinazo Peñalver, Juan S. Fernández and the brothers Abdel Moati, Francis and Raphael Massabki, three Maronite laymen. All were killed in the 1860 Syrian Civil War by the Ottoman Militia because they refused to leave the church and become Muslim.



Three of the new saints founded religious orders. They are **Blessed Marie-Léonie Paradis, Blessed Giuseppe Allamano and Blessed Elena Guerra.**

Born in 1840 in Quebec, **Élodie Paradis** joined the Sisters of the Holy Cross before founding the Little Sisters of the Holy Family, which was dedicated to the education field. Her miracle involved the healing of a newborn baby girl who was born in 1986 in a Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu hospital. The child endured prolonged perinatal asphyxia, with multiple organ failures and encephalopathy, but survived due to

prayers to Blessed Marie - Léonie. The young woman is now a language teacher.

Father Giuseppe Allamano created the Consolata Missionaries and the Consolata Missionary Sisters while also serving as rector of the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Consolation in Turin, Italy. His idea for an annual day for missionaries happened shortly after his death when Pope Pius XI established World Mission Day.

On February 7, 1996, Sorino Yanomami was attacked in the Amazon rainforest by a jaguar, leaving him with a brain injury. The parishioners prayed to Blessed Allamano, and Sorino recovered.

Elena Guerra was born in Lucca, Italy. She had a great devotion to the Holy Spirit and founded the Oblates of the Holy Spirit. She was particularly concerned about the education of Asian and African girls. Her miracle involved the healing of Paulo from Uberlândia, Brazil. He fell from a tree in 2010 and went into a coma with a serious brain injury. He was declared brain dead after ten days, but members of the Charismatic Renewal organized prayer groups by asking everyone to pray to Blessed Elena Guerra. Paul was discharged from the hospital in good condition a month later.

Pope Francis and the Consistory of Cardinals then voted to approve the canonization of the first Saint from Generation Y, people who were born between 1981 and 1996, known as millennials.

Blessed Carlo Acutis was born in London, England on May 3, 1991 to an Italian mother and British/Italian father, who were not especially religious. Known for his devotion to Eucharistic miracles and Marian apparitions, he catalogued these events on a website which he designed. A profoundly spiritual child, he was famous for "welcoming and caring towards the poorest, and he helped the homeless, the needy, and immigrants with the money he saved from his allowance." Carlo died on October 12, 2006, from leukemia in Monza, Italy. His miracle for sainthood is for a young woman from Costa Rica. Valeria Valverde was attending college in Florence. While riding her bicycle, she fell, suffering severe head trauma which required craniotomy surgery.



Her right occipital bone was removed to reduce pressure on her brain. She was given a very low chance of survival. On July 8, 2022, her mother went to Assisi and prayed at Blessed Carlo's tomb, leaving a letter for help.

That day the hospital informed her that Valeria started to breathe naturally. The next day, she began to move and partially regained her speech. A CAT scan was done on July 18, showing that the hemorrhage had disappeared. On August 11, Valeria was moved to rehabilitation therapy, making great progress. Then, on September 2, Valeria and her mother made another pilgrimage to Assisi to thank Blessed Carlo for his intercession.

The names of the new Saints will be added to the List of Saints on Sunday, October 20. The tentative canonizations are being considered for the 2025 Jubilee.
