

says: "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." Once again, you responded to the "ask" of our parish Blood Drive Ministry by donating 21 pints to the Septembe28 drive...and, AGAIN, surpassed our OneBlood assigned goal. Since starting this important outreach ministry on June 19, 2019, we have donated 627 of "liquid goal," thus saving 1,881 lives as each donation can save up to three lives.

En Mateo 7:7, Jesús dice: «Pidan y se les dará; busquen y encontrarán; llamen y se les abrirá la puerta.» Una vez más, ustedes respondieron a la «petición» del Ministerio de Donación de Sangre de nuestra parroquia donando 21 pintas para la donación del 28 de septiembre... y, OTRA VEZ, sobrepasaron nuestra meta asignada de OneBlood. Desde que comenzó este importante ministerio de alcance el 19 de junio de 2019, hemos donado 627 de la «meta líquida», salvando así 1,881 vidas, ya que cada donación puede salvar hasta tres vidas.

Venerable Augustus Tolton By Marylu Mariniello

John Augustus Tolton was an African American who served as the first black Catholic priest in the United States, ordained in Rome in 1886.

Augustine Chisley was born illegitimately and into slavery on April 1, 1854, to Martha Jane in Ralls County, Missouri. He was baptized as "a slave child" owned by Stephen Elliott on May 29, 1854, at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Rensselaer. His master's daughter, Savilla Elliott, was his godmother, who taught her parents' slaves Catholic religion classes, which were minimal, including memorizing the Ten Commandments. His mother was the daughter of Augustus Chisley and Matilda Hurd and the slave of John Henry Manning in Meade County, KY. After his death in 1835, the Chisley children were forcibly separated from their parents, being divided between his different heirs. Martha Jane was given to Ann Manning Elliott as part of a wedding dowry. Per Joyce Duriga, "In 1859 -- five years after Augustus was born -- their respective owners gave Martha Jane and a man named Peter Paul permission to marry. Peter Paul Hagar was a fellow slave who worked on the neighboring Hagar plantation in the distillery."

According to the family's descendants, Stephen Elliott freed all of his slaves at the outbreak of the American Civil War and allowed them to move North, but the estate papers had a different story where he died in debt, and his wife ordered all their property appraised, including the slaves. Peter Paul escaped first and enlisted on in the Third Arkansas Infantry Regiment of Colored Troops at Hannibal, MI. He wanted to fight in the Union Army but died of dysentery on January 12, 1864. Then Martha Jane, Augustine, and younger son Charley ran away. Ann Elliot hired slave catchers to track down the Chisley family under the Fugitive Slave Act of 1850. They were wanted dead or alive. At the time, Union Army



Regiments assigned to Missouri and other border States were under strict orders not to interfere with slavery if the masters took an oath of loyalty to the Union, but the Union soldiers routinely ignored these orders, defying them outright and risking court-martial. Martha and her children were then protected from a potential arrest by the local Union Army garrison, who gave her a rowboat, which she rowed one mile across the Mississippi into the free state of Illinois. There, they found work on a tobacco farm.

Augustine was placed in a class with younger children but was bullied by the older students. Then he tried to attend St. Boni face downtown, but racism ended this.

After Charley died at the age of ten, Augustine met Peter McGirr, an Irish Catholic priest who helped Augustine attend St. Lawrence Catholic school during the winter months when the tobacco factory was closed. The parishioners objected to a black child attending their school, but Father was firm in his decision. Augustine received his First Communion and Confirmation there, using the new surname Tolton. Many runaway slaves routinely chose new last names to protect themselves from possible recapture. Augustine graduated in 1872.

In 1874, two priests asked Augustine, who was now twenty years old, to start a tuition free school for black children in Quincy. The school grew in popularity prompting the Sisters of Notre Dame to send a nun and a postulant from Milwaukee to help teach at the school.


Augustine received opposition from African-American Baptist and Methodist ministers because seven students were baptized into the Catholic Church during the first year, so by 1880 the school was forced to close. Augustine later wrote, "I was a poor slave boy, but the priests of the Church did not disdain me ... It was through one of them that I stand before you this day ... it was through the direction of a Sister of Notre Dame, Sister Herlinda, that I learned to interpret the Ten Commandments, and then I saw for the first time the glimmering light of truth and the majesty of the Church."

While he was teaching, Augustine was admitted to St. Francis Solanus College, now Quincy University, which he attended from 1878 to 1880. At first, white students threatened to leave the college if Augustine stayed, but the Franciscan Order replied that the Church would not discriminate based on skin color and the white students could leave if they wanted. In 1880, Augustine graduated as the valedictorian of his class

Irish-American and German-American Diocesan priests tutored Augustine in Ecclesiastical Latin, Koine Greek, German, ancient and modern history, philosophy, and geography. Even though Augustine was well-educated, multilingual and supported by the local priests and Bishop Peter Joseph Baltes, he was rejected by every North American major seminary he applied to as well as Mill Hill Missionaries in London, so the bishop arranged for Augustine to attend the Pontifical Urban University in Rome, where he was ordained in 1886, saying his first Mass atSt. Peter's Basilica on Easter Sunday. He wanted to serve as a missionary in Africa but was sent back to America to work with other fellow African Americans. He now spoke Italian as well as Ecclesiastical Latin, German, and Greek.

Father offered his first American Mass at St. Mary's Hospital in Hoboken, NJ, on July 7, 1886, and then said a Solemn High Mass at St. Benedict the Moor Catholic Church in New York City on July 11, 1886. Now assigned to the Diocese of Alton, where he ministered at his home parish in Quincy, Father said his first Mass at St. Boniface on July 18, 1886, but had opposition from the German-American dean of the parish and local African-American Protestant ministers. Then he went to the Archdiocese of Chicago, where he spearheaded the development and construction of St. Monica's Church as an African-American "national parish" on Chicago's South Side. With the assistance of philanthropist Katharine Drexel, later becoming St. Katherine Drexel, St. Monica was completed in 1893 at 36th and Dearborn Streets. He was now known as "Good Father Gus," often playing the concertina and singing folk songs in German during parish dances. St. Monica's grew from thirty parishioners to six hundred with the new church building. Father's success at ministering to black Catholics earned him national attention within the Catholic hierarchy. He was known for his "eloquent sermons, his beautiful singing voice, and his talent for playing the accordion." He also opened doors for other black men to attend seminaries in the US and Europe said Mass at Congress, and participated in an international celebration of the centenary of the first Catholic Diocese in the United States.

Father Gus died unexpectedly at the age of forty-three of heat stroke on July 9 during the 1897 Chicago heatwave. His cause for beatification was opened by Cardinal Francis George in 2010. Father Augustus Tolton was declared venerable by Pope Francis in June 2019.




